- Approve Fall Meeting Minutes
- Treasurer's Report and Approval no new information, treasurer shares in the chat , using Darren Johnsons very well laid out system, we are in the black, balance is updated to \$18,187.27
- New Business
- Discussion of google form, a small percentage of teachers are interested in virtual festivals, however very few are willing to host. This is an agenda item that is open for discussion but it is unlikely we will come up with solutions at this time. Question about in person festivals- are they cancelled for the foreseeable future? President does not see a way that we could possibly meet in person. WMEA is working with OSPI to amend the decree that music classes will not be allowed to resume. The evidence has not been well reviewed by OSPI, Karen Helseth of WMEA has sent a letter imploring OSPI to look at the evidence more carefully.
- State guidance about solo and ensemble has not been provided. Our region will be able to provide some type of performance experience for students for those who are working on solos. There is a WMEA board meeting coming up in the next couple of weeks and hopefully we will gain clarity at that time. All-State will be cancelled, held outdoors at the end of june or auditioned named and not held. Educator's conference will be online.
- Members provided many ideas for things they would like to discuss which can be addressed in monthly subject area meetings.
